QFHS has a Buddy Program for New Members. The aim of the Buddy Program is to help you, as new member, feel at ease in the Society and to encourage you to access as many of the Society's services and activities as possible. If you wish to participate in our Buddy Program, our Coordinator will find an experienced Member to be your Buddy. The Buddy Program is an addition to all the benefits already provided by your Society and is free of charge. We envisage that the Buddy-New Member relationship would last for 3-6 months.

What you and your Buddy do is largely up to you as the New Member. Your Buddy should contact you several times during the Buddy-New Member term, check how you are progressing with your research, and support you in visiting the Library and Resource Centre. Your Buddy might:

- Arrange to be at the Library and Resource Centre for your first visit and introduce you to the Library Assistants,
- Accompany you to your first Special Interest Group meeting,
- Accompany you to a QFHS Seminar or Friday@QFHS. You will receive a voucher to enable you and your Buddy to attend one Seminar or Friday@QFHS together at no cost to either person.
- Provide you with some guidance and direction in relation to your research,
- Check with you as to how your research is progressing and suggest additional avenues of research,
- Tell you about other opportunities e.g. New Members' Welcome and Orientation, Trout Game, ULP seminars, seminars at the State Library of Queensland or at the Queensland State Archives.
