Saturday, 19 September 2020	Working life—at home and further afield	Adjective/noun stacks

- Remember, it is your choice whether
  - o you write at all or just come along to enjoy the fellowship, or
  - o you write on any suggested topic
  - o contribute to the discussion

#### **About your writing**

- We request you adhere to the 750 word limit
- Before you write, ask yourself:
  - O Who is my audience?
  - O What is the purpose of my story?
- After you have written your story and before the meeting, we suggest you read it aloud (to yourself or a captive audience) and check for readability and listenability <sup>1</sup>
   Ask yourself:
  - Are full dates necessary and significant?
  - o Is an exhaustive listing of all members of a family necessary and significant?
  - o Is my meaning clear?
  - o Have I used a variety of sentence constructions?
  - Have I used straightforward, as opposed to complex, sentence constructions?
  - o Have I been careful with my use of pronouns—he, she, him, her, it, etc.?
