QFHS Inc. Family History Book Award Guidelines

As a guide to entrants the following points indicate the judging criteria. It may be useful to use this as a checklist before submitting your work to the Society.

Scope and planning of the work

- History of a family not an individual
- Queensland content
- Pre-immigration component if relevant
- Placement of the family in its historical setting
- Did the publication achieve its objectives?

Content – these items are critical to the work

- Title page full title, author, publisher, location, date
- Reverse title page copyright statement, edition, reprints
- Table of contents
- Full citation of references footnotes/endnotes giving sources and locations
- Bibliography or list of sources
- Comprehensive and accurate index names, places, other categories as applicable
- Acknowledgements and appropriate recognition of copyright (<u>www.copyright.org.au</u>) and respect of privacy (<u>www.privacy.gov.au</u>)

Presentation

- English expression
- Arrangement of content page numbering, style, syntax, chapters
- Readability font size and suitability
- Illustrations such as photographs, maps, diagrams and their sources should be appropriate and referred to in text
- Clarity of data and genealogical tables

Overall impression – interesting story, historical setting, historical accuracy.
